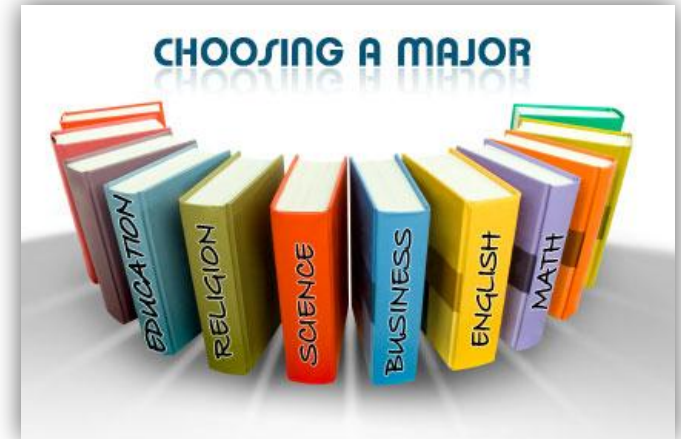

Course focus:

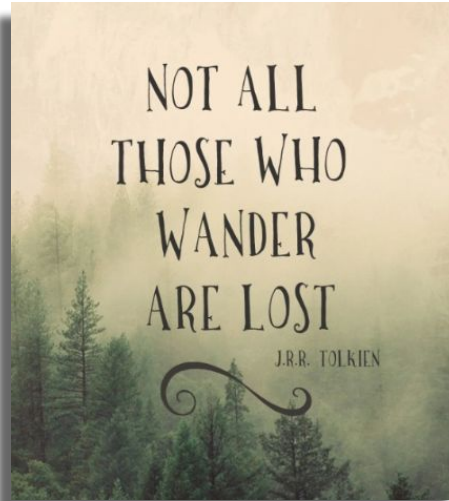

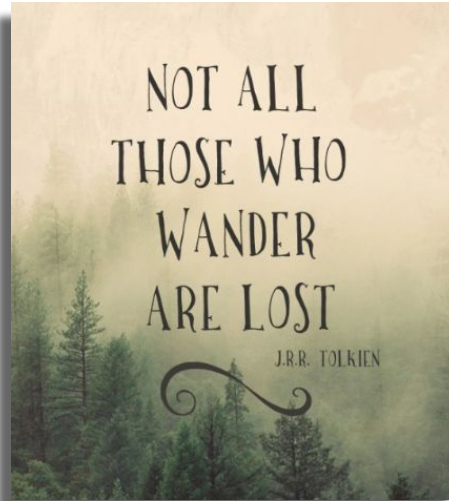

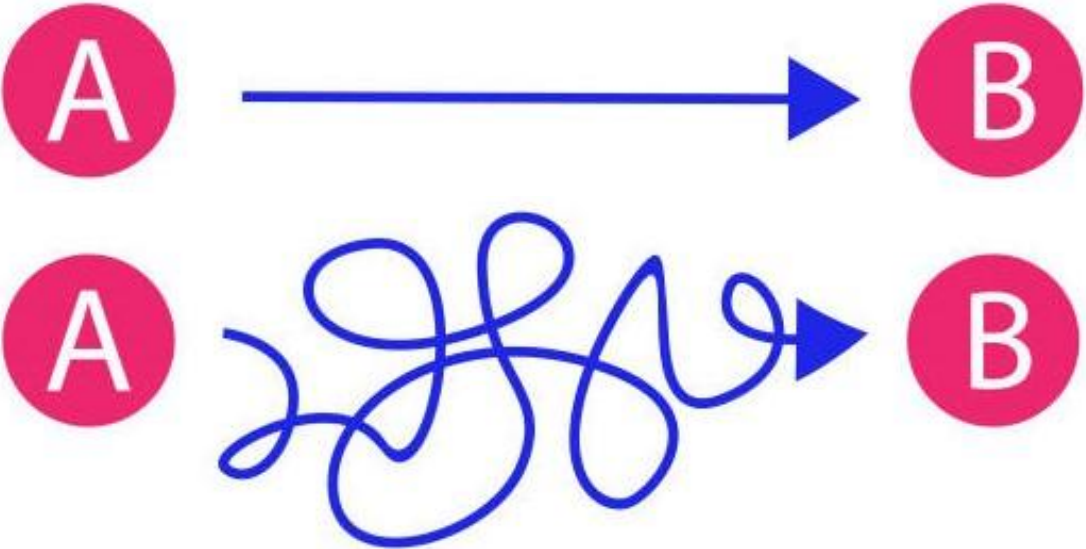

Academic Advising in University College

Advisor Responsibilities

- To listen
- To be prompt (calls, emails, etc.)
- To provide information about academic services and resources
- To help the student define academic and career goals
- To interpret and explain complex university policies to the student

Student Responsibilities

- To provide accurate and honest information
- To schedule and keep appointments
- To establish an agenda for advising appointments
- To be open to advice and new ideas
